### VINEYARD COMPOSITION

All fruit for our 2021 Red Blend came from four vineyards in the Columbia Valley: Cold Creek, Alder Ridge, Canoe Ridge, and Summit View.

### VARIETAL COMPOSITION

This blend is comprised of 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Malbec, 9% Merlot, 3% Zinfandel, and 2% Cabernet Franc.

### ÉLEVAGE

The wine spent 18 months in 35% new French oak barrels, and then an additional 4 months in stainless steel tanks.

### TASTING NOTES FROM THE WINEMAKER

Earthy, spicy, and flush with ripe red berries, our 2021 History Red Blend is vibrant and mouthwatering. Notes of huckleberry, black pepper, cayenne, and red clay come through on the nose, while the palate is long and bright with eloquent tannins. There is a hint of ferrous minerality that draws the wine to a complex, lingering finish.

### VINTAGE OVERVIEW

The 2021 growing season was warmer than average, with a dry heat throughout the summer. In the Columbia Valley, this resulted in the fruit being ripe earlier in the season, giving us grapes full of vibrant and focused flavors.
